After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended and satisfied in case, he makes a representation to the competent person then they should decide the same by passing speaking and reasoned order.

Given above, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty as prayed for. It is clarified that as and when the petitioner makes a representation qua the matter in issue, then the concerned officer shall decide the same within 30 working days from the date of receipt of the representation, by passing a speaking and reasoned order. Petitioner is at liberty to come to this Court, in case need arises. This order shall remain in force till one month only.
