

Ashok Kumar Versus Mamchand and others

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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.2,50,000/- (Rupees Two lakh and fifty thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant – Ashok Kumar.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque/demand draft for Rs.2,50,000/- in the name of appellant – Ashok Kumar within a period of four weeks in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the crossed-cheque/demand draft from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
