1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 17.05.2022 in CWP-10523-2022.
2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 17.05.2022 reveals that CWP-10523-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide legal notice dated 21.06.2021 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
3. At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of order dated 26.10.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof, states that in the circumstances she does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 26.10.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty as prayed for.
