The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0074 dated 1.8.2022 registered under Sections 376 and 506 IPC at Police Station, Sadar Moga, District Moga.

By virtue of the order dated 6.10.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 6.10.2022 petitioner has joined investigation and fully cooperated. He submits that both petitioner and prosecutrix are living as husband and wife and thus the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the submissions made by counsel for petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh has endorsed the fact that petitioner has joined investigation and submitted that he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 6.10.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
