AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition is filed seeking directions to the respondents to club the FIRs registered against the petitioner i.e. FIR No. 34 dated 12.5.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at P.S. Sector 49, Chandigarh, FIR No. 64 dated 19.8.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420 IPC at P.S. Sector 49, Chandigarh, FIR No. 67 dated 25.8.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC at P.S. Sector 49, Chandigarh, FIR No. 89 dated 11.11.2021 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B, IPC at P.S. Sector 49, Chandigarh.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the UT Chandigarh raises a preliminary objection that the relief prayed in petition can be sought before the Trial Court.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would avail remedies in accordance with law, before charges are framed.

Petition is disposed of as not pressed, with liberty as prayed for.

There is no doubt that in case such remedy is availed, the Court concerned will consider the same in accordance with law.
