DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has approached this Court under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking protection of her lives and personal liberty from respondents No.4 to 7.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that the petitioner has submitted a representation dated 01.10.2022 to the respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Hisar for saving her life and liberty, but the said representation has not been decided.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy, Mr. Gurmeet Singh, AAG Haryana has appeared and accepted notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a representation dated 01.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) has also been sent by the petitioner to the respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police, Hisar for protecting her life and liberty, but the said representation has not been decided.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the said representation has not been received by respondent No. 2, but as he has received the advance copy of the petition and has no objection if

appropriate directions are given for deciding the representation submitted by the petitioner.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the the petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Superintendent of Police Hisar, to look into the grievances of the petitioner as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation dated 01.10.2022 (Annexure P-2) and take appropriate action for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner as may be warranted by the circumstances.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition to respondent No.2- Superintendent of Police, Hisar for requisite compliance.

The petition is disposed of.
