This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 and not to harass the petitioners on any false criminal complaint.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Shashank Bhandari, Addl. P.P., U.T. Chandigarh, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation dated 02.10.2022 (Annexure P-5) alleged to have been submitted by petitioner No.2 seeking protection for their lives and personal liberty.

Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioners and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law.
