This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8 and restraining them from interfering in their personal, peaceful life.

Notice of motion.

Mr. V.G. Jauhar, Addl. A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3-State.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that let this petition be disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to consider and decide the representation dated 29.09.2022 (Annexure P-3) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners seeking protection of their life and liberty.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter and in particular the legality of the alleged relationship, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to forthwith consider the aforesaid representation dated 29.09.2022 (Annexure P-3) made on behalf of the petitioners and thereafter, take appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the alleged relationship between the petitioners or protect them from legal action for violation, if any, committed by them.
