The present appeal has been filed against the judgment dated 23.09.2022, passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur whereby the application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.111 dated 13.09.2022 registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur under Sections 323, 34 of IPC and 3/1 (x) SC & ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the appellant at the outset contends that FIR was registered against three persons namely Jasveer Singh s/o Naranjan, Parminder Singh @ Paramjit Singh alias Pamma s/o Gurwinder Singh and Jagtar Singh son of Gurmail Singh under afore-stated sections.

Learned counsel for the appellants further submits that a Coordinate Bench of this Court in the case of co-accused Jasveer Singh

in CRA-S-1907-2022 has passed order dated 29.09.2022 whereby relying upon judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar 2014 (8) SCC 273**, Police Authorities have been directed to comply with Section 41-A of Cr.P.C.

Learned Counsel states that present appeal may be disposed of in the same terms.

The case of present appellant is at par with the case of co-accused whose appeal CRA-S-1907-2022 has been disposed of vide order dated 29.09.2022. The present appeal is disposed of in the same terms as CRA-S-1907-2022.
