As agreed, as per statements of the learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of respondent No.3 - Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lac Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is allowed to the appellants in full & final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with the direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.1,50,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/office shall issue a proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel,/representative of the respondent No.3 - Insurance Company. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
