1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 06.07.2021, in CWP-11680-2021.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 06.07.2021, reveals that CWP-11680-2021 was disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to take a decision on the charge-sheet dated 23.07.2020 in accordance with law within four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record copy of order dated 22.02.2022 imposing punishment on the petitioner qua charge-sheet dated 23.07.2020. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same

with liberty to challenge order dated 22.02.2022 by way of appropriate

proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
