In the present petition, the petitioners challenge to the orders Annexures P-5 to P-11 by which, the petitioners have been transferred. The grievance of the petitioners is that the petitioners have been transferred contrary to the transfer policy Annexure P-3, as amended on 05.06.2017 (Annexure P-4).

While issuing notice of motion on 18.09.2019, the operation of the impugned orders was stayed. The learned State counsel submits that keeping in view the fact that the petitioners are already working at the place prior to the issuance of the impugned order, he has instructions to submit that the impugned order will not be given effect to qua the petitioners any further and the department be given liberty to consider the petitioners for transfer in accordance with law henceforth.

Keeping in view the above, as the respondents have already stated that the impugned order will not be given to any effect any further, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as

such with liberty to the respondents as prayed for.
