BAHADUR SINGH V/S DINESH KUMAR AND OTHERS.

In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 125 days in filing the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing the appeal is condoned.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and representative of the respondent Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.55,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant-Bahadur Singh.

The enhanced amount is to be credited to the account of the claimant within a period of 4 weeks from today. The counsel for the appellant/claimant is directed to furnish the bank account details to the counsel for the Insurance Company within a period of one week from today. In case the appellant/claimant fails to provide the bank details for the purpose of transfer of amount so enhanced here-in-above, the Insurance Company will be at liberty to issue demand draft against the said amount.

It is further made clear that in case the Insurance Company fails to deposit the amount of enhanced compensation within the stipulated period of four weeks, it shall carry interest @ 9% per annum from the date it became due till the

date of the realization.

The present appeal is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
