1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/10 dated 19.04.2018, in CWP-9392-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/10 reveals that CWP-9392-2018, was disposed of while granting liberty to the petitioner to file a detailed and comprehensive representation raising all the pleas as raised in the writ petition before the appropriate authority and the appropriate authority was directed that in case any such representation was filed by the petitioner within six months, from the date of receipt of certified copy of the same, the same be decided in accordance with law as also by keeping in view the principles of law enunciated by Hon'ble the Full Bench of this Court in Rajiv Manchanda and others vs. Haryana Urban Development Authority, Panchkula and others, CWP-22252-2016, decided on 22.11.2017.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in

view of representation submitted by the petitioner having been decided

by the respondent and although relief to which the petitioner is entitled to in terms of order dated 18.06.2019, has not been granted to the petitioner, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to make an application for allotment of a plot of the appropriate size in terms of the decision of Hon'ble the Division Bench in Rajiv Manchanda's case (supra) as and when a new scheme for allotment of plots is floated by the respondents.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
