AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is a petition seeking directions to Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents (arrayed in the petition).

The grievance raised is that applications (Annexures P1 and P2) are not being considered by the authorities.

From the perusal of the pleadings, it is forthcoming that the petitioners and private respondents are relatives. There is a dispute with regard to inheritance of the property left by father-in-law of the petitioner No. 1. There is a registered Will left by the deceased and civil litigations are pending between the parties. The petitioners are accused in FIR No. 16 dated 29.12.2021, under Sections 451, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No. 1, Ludhiana. There is no specific incident specified in the representation which either shows a cognizable offence or an incident for making the basis for apprehension of threat.

Apart from the bald statement, there is nothing on record calling for interference by this court under the writ jurisdiction.

The petition is dismissed.
