[1] Prayer in the petition is for taking action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 12.02.2021 in CWP No.3305 of 2021.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 12.02.2021 reveals that CWP No.3305 of 2021 was disposed of by directing the competent authority to decide legal notice served by the petitioner in accordance with law by passing a speaking order within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Pursuant to issuance of notice to the respondents to show cause as to why proceedings under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 be not initiated against them, reply along with speaking order dated 13.01.2021 rejecting the claim of the petitioner, has been filed by respondent No.4. Copy of the reply along with speaking order has already been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of order, Annexure R/1 dated 13.10.2021 states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition instead be granted

liberty to challenge speaking order, Annexure R/1 dated 13.10.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
