Learned counsel for the respondents submits that this appeal is rendered infructuous as the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties. Copy of order dated 30.07.2019, passed by Additional District and Sessions Judge/MACT, Gurugram, has been produced in Court, wherein it is observed as under:-

“It is stated by counsel for DH that compromise has been effected between the parties as per which an amount of Rs.3,67,082/- vide DD No. 721135 dated 24.07.2019 is given to the decree holder by JD as full and final payment. No other payment shall remain outstanding on JD. Heard. In view of the statement made by counsel for DH, the present execution petition is dismissed as withdrawn. File be consigned to record room after due compliance.”

Learned counsel for the appellant however submits that he does not have any instructions to this effect.

Be that as it may, in view of order dated 30.07.2019 passed by the learned Additional District and Sessions Judge/ MACT, Gurugram, this appeal is indeed rendered infructuous. Copy of order dated 30.07.2019, is taken on record subject to just exceptions.

Appeal is accordingly disposed of as infructuous. Liberty is afforded to the appellant to file an appropriate application within four weeks, in case any inaccurate fact has been brought forth before this Court.
