The instant petition has been preferred for quashing of the order dated 06.06.2022 (Annexure P-6), whereby the petitioners' bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State and petitioners have been summoned through non-bailable warrants.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners are real sisters and petitioner No.2 is pregnant and petitioner No.1 was taking care of her, due to which both the petitioners could not appear before the trial Court on 06.06.2022. He further submits that the non-appearance of the petitioners is neither intentional nor deliberate.

Keeping in view the peculiar facts and circumstances and also to meet the ends of justice the petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court within two weeks from today and to apply for regular bail.

In case, such an application for bail is moved by the petitioners

before the trial Court, the same shall be considered and decided on the same date in accordance with law.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.

The afore-said relief is granted subject to payment of costs of ₹5000/- in the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Sector 12, Chandigarh.
