1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 01.03.2018/14.12.2017, in CWP-5080-2018.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-5080-2018, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 31.01.2018 and take a conscious decision in respect thereto, in accordance with law and rules, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel by referring to speaking order Annexure R-1/T and R-2/T dated 19.04.2018 and 17.01.2020, states that in view of payment as per entitlement having been made by the respondents to the petitioner, the petitioner may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
