VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a second petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.53 dated 11.08.2022 registered under Sections 22(c) and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, Act, 1985 at Police Station Kot Fatta, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition and has further submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days and prays that in case the petitioner applies for regular bail after surrender, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 5 days.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application, however, does not object to the said course of action.

Keeping in view the above said statement made by learned

with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within a period of 10 days and in case after surrendering, the petitioner files an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 5 days from the date of the said application being filed.
