VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.145 dated 17.08.2022 registered under Sections 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances, Act, 1985 (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added later on) at Police Station Garhshankar, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, and seeing that this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter, in order to avoid an adverse order on merits, seeks to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the police within a period of 10 days and prays that in case the petitioner applies for regular bail after surrender, the same be decided as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 5 days.

Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application,

however, does not object to the said course of action.

Keeping in view the above said statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the police within a period of 10 days and in case after surrendering, the petitioner files an application for regular bail, the trial Court is directed to decide the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of 5 days from the date of the said application being filed.
