This is the petitioner's second attempt to get the bail during the pendency of the trial in a criminal case arising from FIR No.132, dated 30.12.2017, registered under Section 302/458 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 182, 211 and 120-B IPC added and Section 458 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 deleted subsequently), at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

In the investigation, it has come into the notice that the petitioner murdered his own father in order to falsely implicate the various persons with whom he had a criminal case. The police after investigation has found that the petitioner hatched a conspiracy along with the other accused to murder his father which was ultimately executed.

The petitioner claims bail as Sh. Gurpreet Singh has not supported the case of the prosecution. The trial Court has considered the aforesaid fact and found that if the applicant is released on bail, he can influence the remaining material witnesses who are yet to be examined. It is not in dispute that the statement of the prosecution's witnesses are being

recorded.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, no ground to grant the concession of bail is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
