**CRM-M No.47628 of 2022**

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for  
setting aside the order dated 19.07.2022 (Annexure P-5) passed by  
Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana in case titled as “State Vs. Arvinder  
Singh Etc.” bearing case No.SC/58/2022 registered under Section 379 IPC  
and Section 21 of Mines and Minerals Act, 1957 in FIR No.138 dated  
22.03.2018 at Police Station Sadar, Jagraon, District Ludhiana whereby the  
bail bonds were ordered to be cancelled and the surety bonds submitted in  
support thereof were ordered to be forfeited, as the petitioner failed to  
appear before the trial Court.

The affidavit has been filed wherein the petitioner states that  
inadvertently date of hearing was noted down by him as 29.07.2022 instead

of 19.07.2022. On 29.07.2022 when he contacted his Advocate he was told that the matter was earlier listed for 19.07.2022 now stand adjourned to 20.10.2022. It was only thereafter that the petitioner came to know about the orders regarding cancellation of the bail bonds and issuance of non-bailable warrants.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that he has no objection in case the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court before the next date of hearing, which is stated to be fixed for 03.01.2023.

In view of the aforesaid facts, the present petition is disposed off with the direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 03.01.2023. On his doing so and in case he files an application seeking admission to bail, the same shall be decided by the trial Court preferably on the same day in accordance with law.

Disposed off accordingly.
