The plaintiffs assail the correctness of interlocutory order passed by the trial court while dismissing the application for permission to produce certified copy of the deposition of defendant's father in additional evidence.

The learned counsel representing the petitioners contends that the certified copy of the deposition of defendant's father is *per-se* admissible.

This court is afraid that the aforesaid contention is not correct. The deposition of a witness in some other proceedings can only be used for confronting the witness in cross-examination. Further the petitioners have already availed 13 opportunities to lead evidence and they were in knowledge of the copy of the statement.

In view thereof, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
