1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 24.05.2019, in CWP-14013-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1, reveals that CWP-14013-2019, was disposed of vide order dated 24.05.2019, by directing the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 25.03.2019 within three months of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case, it was found that the petitioner was entitled to any monetary benefits, to release the same to him within three months thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to issuance of notice, the respondents have released financial benefits to the petitioner as per his entitlement in terms of the claim made in representation dated 25.03.2019, therefore, in the circumstances, the

petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be

permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
