Present writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release full pay/salary of the petitioner along with arrears with all consequential benefits and interest on the delayed payment.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case representation dated 31.07.2022 (P-5) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Lavanya Paul, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim of petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid representation as per law, within four weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needles to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition.
