GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.178 dated 01.10.2021 at Police Station Kotwali, District Bathinda, under Sections 307/323/427/506/148/149 IPC, wherein it is alleged that the petitioner alongwith co-accused had inflicted injuries to the complainant namely Mohinder Kumar.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the instant FIR came to be lodged under some misunderstanding, which has since been resolved amongst the parties and that the petitioner in any case has not been attributed any injury. It has been submitted that pursuant to the compromise having been effected amongst the parties, a separate petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of

compromise i.e. CRM-M-7165-2022 has already been filed in this Court.

3. While learned State counsel has feigned ignorance about the compromise, but Mr. L.S.Sekhon, Advocate, representing the complainant has admitted the factum of compromise and also filing of the quashing petition on the basis of compromise. Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that he has no objection for grant of bail to the petitioner.
4. In view of the aforestated position, wherein the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties and the complainant has no objection for grant of bail and the challan otherwise already stands presented, the petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
