Case taken up through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the sentence of the petitioners had been suspended by the Appellate Court. The petitioners, however, could not appear on one date as they were down with dengue and consequently, their bail bonds were cancelled. He further contends that the petitioners have also preferred an application under Section 147 of the Negotiable Instruments Act for settlement of the dispute as the petitioners are ready to pay the cheque amount. The petitioners shall pay the cheque amount along with interest at the rate of 6% per annum within a period of one month from now. He undertakes that the petitioners shall henceforth appear before the Appellate Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent themselves except with the prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 09.12.2021, had directed petitioners to appear before the Appellate Court and in the event of their doing so, they were ordered to be released on interim bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Appellate Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that petitioner has appeared before the Appellate Court on 13.12.2021 and has been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, the order dated 09.12.2021 granting interim bail to petitioners is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.
