This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in GD no.059 dated 22.08.2022 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 427, 447, 511, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural as a cross case arising out of FIR no.0227 dated 22.08.2022 registered under Sections 324, 506, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC added later on vide GD no.16 dated 24.08.2022) at Police Station Jandiala, District Amritsar Rural.

On 12.10.2022, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

*“Inter alia contends that the present case is a case of version and cross version and FIR no.227 dated 22.08.2022 was registered by the father of the petitioner namely, Dr.Amarjit Singh Judge, against the complainant in the present case Avtar Singh and other persons as they had inflicted grievous injuries on the father of the petitioner. It is further submitted that even as per the cross version which has been recorded on the statement of Avtar Singh, no specific injury caused to any person has been attributed to the present petitioner. It is stated that co-accused of the petitioner i.e., Dr. Amarjit Singh Judge, has filed the petition for the concession of anticipatory bail in which, notice of motion was*

*issued for 31.10.2022 and interim protection has been granted.*

*Notice of motion for 31.10.2022.*

*To be heard along with CRM-M-45185-2022*

*In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting / Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance of the said order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Dalwinder Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances moreso, the facts which have been noticed in the order dated 12.10.2022, and also the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further investigation, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 12.10.2022 is made absolute.

Nothing stated above shall be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case and the trial would proceed independently of the observations made in the present case which are only for the purpose of adjudicating the present bail petition.
