Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.125 dated 2.11.2021 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station GRP Rewari, District Rewari.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is further contended that the petitioner never compelled or incited Deepak to commit suicide. He further submits that the petitioner has joined investigation with the police by virtue of order dated 6.12.2021 passed by this Court.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Hari Om has not refuted the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation. He further submits that the petitioner is facing some other criminal cases but he is on bail in all those cases.

As per allegations appearing on record, in the instant case, dead body of Deepak was recovered from railway line and as per prosecution version, the present petitioner and one Ashish humiliated and compelled the deceased to commit suicide by jumping before the running train.

Admittedly, no suicide note was left behind by deceased Deepak. It is a matter of evidence as to whether the petitioner ever abetted deceased Deepak to end his life by committing suicide. The petitioner has already joined investigatoin and challan has also been presented by the police on completion of investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 6.12.2021 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
