1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.07.2022, in CWP-16383-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-16383-2022, was disposed of by directing respondent No.5 herein to consider and decide legal notice dated 01.07.2022 and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned AAG, Punjab, on instructions from respondent No.5 states that claim of the petitioner has been decided vide order dated 29.08.2022 and that payment as per entitlement determined therein, would be released to the petitioner within one week from today. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition and may be permitted

to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while directing respondent No.5 to adhere to the assurance held out by him through the learned AAG, Punjab and to release the payment to the petitioner as per entitlement determined vide order Annexure P/3 dated 25.08.2022, within one week from today, failing which, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the instant petition.
