[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 27.03.2018 in CWP No.18565 of 2016 in case titled as Balwinder Singh vs. PSPCL and Ors.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.18565 of 2016 was allowed in terms of the decision in CWP No.17100 of 2016 in case titled as Paramjit Singh vs. PSPCL and Ors whereas a perusal of decision in Paramjit Singh's case reveals that the aforementioned writ petition and the other connected petitions were allowed in terms of decision in ***CWP No.20139 of 2015 in case titled as Chiman Singh vs. Punjab State Power Corporation and others, decided on 29.02.2016*** and the respondents were directed to treat the petitioner(s) at par with the petitioner(s) in Chiman Singh's case and to consider the claim of the petitioner(s) in the light of the said decision and pass consequential orders within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 27.03.2018, claim of the petitioner has been decided and benefits as per entitlement have been released to the petitioner vide order, Annexure R/1 dated 30.09.2019, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and he may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
