The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the FIR No.104 dated 20.04.2012 registered under Sections 406 and 506/34 IPC (Sections 326, 343, 324, 379, 148 and 149 IPC added later on), at Police Station, Cantonment Amritsar City, Distt. Amritsar, in which two times cancellation report has been submitted by the official respondents, however, both the times, the learned trial Court has not accepted the same and rather, has ordered re-investigation.

After arguing for some, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to all the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
