Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the present petition has been filed for the grant of regular bail to the petitioner but as out of the total 10 witnesses cited to be examined, 06 witnesses have already been examined, the trial Court be directed to conclude the trial within a specified period so that the petitioner does not suffer indefinite incarceration.

Learned State counsel raises no objection for the grant of said prayer of the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that out of the total 10 witnesses cited to be examined, 06 witnesses have already been examined and the petitioner is behind the bars for the last one year and six months, the present petition is disposed off with the direction to the trial Court to make all the efforts to

conclude the trial within a period of 04 months from the next date of hearing, even if, the same is to be done by giving short adjournments.
