Learned counsel for cross-objector/respondent No.3-Insurance
Company prays for withdrawal of the cross-objection.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

FAO No. 688 of 2016:

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants
and learned counsel for respondent No.3-Bajaj Allianz General Insurance
Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees Six Lacs
Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the
appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the
statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid
to appellant No.1-Meera Devi.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for an amount of Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees Six Lacs Only) in the name of appellant No.1-Meera Devi with the Office of Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of one month in compliance of this order, failing which interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of respondent No.3-Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company. The appellants' counsel/appellants may collect the cheque from the Office of Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
