This is a first petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. praying for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.87 dated 13.05.2021 registered under Section 379 IPC at Police Station Tibba, District Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel has pointed out that in the present case, neither complainant Ranjit Singh nor eye witness Mohd. Vaseem have been examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition after examination of the above said complainant Ranjit Singh and eye witness Mohd. Vaseem. It has further been prayed that the trial be expedited since the petitioner has been in custody since 14.06.2021.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh petition for regular bail after examination of complainant Ranjit Singh and eye witness Mohd. Vaseem and the trial Court is requested to expedite the trial and to examine the said witnesses as expeditiously as possible.

It is made clear that the second petition for regular bail, if any, filed by the petitioner, shall be considered independently, on its merit, in accordance with law.
