The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of the India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to take appropriate action in accordance with law regarding the representations submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.2 dated 12.06.2019 (Annexure P-2) and reminder dated 20.07.2022 (Annexure P-3).

Being confronted with the fact that the petitioner has another alternative and efficacious remedy available to him in accordance with law under the enabling provisions of Criminal Procedure of Law, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to him in accordance with law.
