1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 09.09.2022, in CWP-20545-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-20545-2022, was disposed of in view of statement of the learned AAG, Haryana, that the application filed by the petitioner would be decided within ten days from the date of order.

3. At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 08.10.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in the application filed by him. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order dated 08.10.2022, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to challenge order dated 08.10.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
