The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 31.05.2019 (Annexure P-5) seeking release of the balance payment for the work executed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents – State submits that the due amount has already been transferred to the account of the petitioner vide Cheque No.000697 dated 14.01.2022.

In view of above, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner does not press the instant petition, at this stage. However, he prays that liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies to seek compensatory interest for the delayed payment of the amount in accordance with law.

Disposed of as not pressed with liberties as aforesaid.
