The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.50 dated 11.9.2021 registered under Sections 376, 384, 506 IPC at Police Station, NRI, District SAS Nagar, Mohali.

By virtue of the order dated 24.2.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 24.2.2022 petitioner has joined investigation. He submits that in pursuance to order dated 2.8.2022, passed by this court petitioner has again joined the investigation. Counsel prays for making the interim order absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by counsel for petitioner and submits that recovery of dowry articles remains to be effected.

Learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Sanjeev Kumar, D.S.P., NRI Wing, District SAS Nagar. Same

is taken on record. State counsel on instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh submits that petitioner has joined investigation. He submits that house of the petitioner was searched and petitioner also furnished an affidavit dated 20.8.2022 wherein it was stated that iPhone was sold by him and his current Samsung mobile phone which has his saved data, has already been deposited with the investigating agency. It was further stated in the affidavit that he did not have any Laptop or computer or any other device and he has never purchased any Laptop or computer. State counsel submits that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 24.2.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
