The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.12 dated 19.01.2021, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Sandaur, District Sangrur.

None had appeared on 15.11.2022, despite the case having been called twice. The same is the position today.

A perusal of the petition reveals that the petitioner was granted indulgence by this Court vide order dated 23.09.2022, however, the petitioner did not surrender, as is evident from para Nos.8 and 9 of the petition.

In view of the provisions of the judgment passed by this Court in CRM-M-31405 of 2021 titled "Sanjiv Vig versus state of Punjab" decided on 06.08.2021, the present petition is not maintainable as such the same is dismissed granting the petitioner liberty to avail of any alternate remedy that may be available to her in accordance with law.
