The prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of direction to the respondent nos.2 & 3 to transfer the investigation of the case to the respondent no.5 in case FIR No.40 dated 26.07.2021 under Sections 379-B, 324, 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station City Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla along with Cross Case registered vide General Diary No.023 dated 22.10.2021 registered under Sections 447, 511, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC.

On 10.12.2021 the following order was passed:-

“ *Notice of motion.*

On the asking of the Court, Mr. B.S. Sewak, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Let requisite number of copies of the Paper-book be supplied to

him.

To come up on 17.01.2022.

Status Report/Reply must be filed on or before the next date of hearing.

Pursuant to the aforesaid order, status report dated 24.03.2022 has been submitted in the Court. The petitioner and the respondent no.8 have levelled allegations and counter allegations regarding the number of FIRs registered against the Petitioner.

Without going into the merits of the rival contentions of either sides, I deem it appropriate to entrust the investigation of case FIR No.40 dated 26.07.2021 under Sections 379-B, 324, 341, 323, 148, 149 IPC registered at Police Station City Ahmedgarh, District Malerkotla along with Cross Case registered vide General Diary No.023 dated 22.10.2021 registered under Sections 447, 511, 506, 427, 148, 149 IPC to the Inspector General of Police Range, Patiala for investigation who shall conclude the investigation within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

It may also be relevant to mention here that the parties have agreed in principle that they shall have no objection in case the aforementioned officer conducts the investigation and proceed in accordance with law.
