1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 3.7.2019, in CWP-17491-2019.

3. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 3.7.2019 reveals that CWP-17491-2019, was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 14.1.2019 within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case of finding any amount due to the petitioner, to release the same without any delay.

4. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that

the petitioner as per his entitlement, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

5. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel.

6. Admittedly, payment due as per entitlement has been released to the petitioner in compliance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 3.7.2019, in CWP-17491-2019.

7. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
