HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that present petition is pending for the last approximately two and half years and as claim of the petitioner is for the grant of retirement benefits, the petitioner may kindly be allowed to withdraw this petition with liberty to file a representation with respondents No. 1 to 3 as well as respondent No.4 claiming the said benefit and the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

Learned counsel for respondent No.4 raises no objection.

Keeping in view the request of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to the

petitioner to file appropriate representation with the authorities concerned raising the claim for the grant of retirement benefits in respect of the service which he is stated to have rendered with them.

In case, any such representation is filed, the respondents authorities with whom the said representation would be filed i.e. respondents No. 1 to 3 as well as respondent No.4, are directed to decide the said representation within a period of eight weeks by passing an appropriate speaking order.

It is made clear that in case after the decision of the representation, the petitioner is found entitled for any monetary amount, the same be also released to him with a period of eight weeks thereafter.
