This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. praying for quashing of FIR No.26 dated 28.02.2018 registered under Section 323, 324, 34 IPC at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

On 18.10.2022 this Court had directed the parties to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate / trial Court for recording their statements qua compromise within a period of 15 days and the said Court was directed to submit its report. The Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has submitted his report and as per said report, in addition to respondents no.2 and 3, Sukhpal Kaur is also stated to be a victim, who has neither been made party nor with whom, the petitioners have entered into the compromise. It is also stated in the report that Sukhwinder Kaur Gill-respondent no.3 has also not come forward to give her statement in support of the compromise.

In view of the same, it seems that the compromise has not

fructified and accordingly, the present petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to file a fresh petition for quashing of the above said FIR in case the compromise is still effectual and after impleading all the parties and after entering into the compromise with all the parties.
