ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 82 dated 11.04.2019, under Section 305 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted bail and he had been appearing regularly before the Court except on 07.10.2021, as he had met with an accident and remained admitted in PGIMER, Chandigarh, and consequently, his bail was cancelled. A copy of the discharge and follow-up card of the PGIMER, Chandigarh is at Annexure P11. He undertakes that the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with prior permission of the Court.

This Court, by the order dated 09.12.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and he was to be released on ad-interim bail to its satisfaction.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court on 30.12.2021 in terms of the previous order of this Court.

In view of the above and the petitioner having appeared before the trial Court, the order dated 09.12.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and shall not absent himself except with the prior permission of the trial court.

The petition stands disposed of.
