Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.81 dated 19.04.2017 under Sections 379B & 411 IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was appearing before the trial Court and in the meantime, one of the co-accused was killed by gangsters, while in custody, when he was appearing before the trial Court. The petitioner also suffered multiple injuries and was remained admitted in the hospital. It is further submitted that feeling threat to his life, the petitioner could not appear before the trial Court and subsequently, he was declared

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proclaimed offender on 26.09.2019. It is also submitted that the petitioner has re-arrested and now he is in custody for the last 05 months and 17 days and one of his similarly situated co-accused Lovepreet Singh was granted the concession of anticipatory bail vide order dated 07.09.2021 passed in CRM-M-36764-2021.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate dated 31.01.2022, filed in the Court today, has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the aforesaid submissions, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
