Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.86 dated 26.06.2020, registered under Sections 120- B, 307, 379-B IPC, at Police Station Buria, District Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

Status report by way of affidavit dated 24.03.2022 of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar, already filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been named in the FIR; that injured, namely, Sharwan Kumar, has also not named the petitioner in the statement recorded under Section 161 Cr.P.C.; that the alleged recovery of axe used in the crime, which is shown to be effected from the petitioner is still disputed; that the petitioner has been in custody since 14.08.2020 and that there is no other case registered and/or pending against the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner has nothing to do with the alleged crime.

Learned State counsel contends that there are specific allegations against the petitioner and the co-accused that they had inflicted as many as five injuries upon the person of the injured and also snatched gold chain, locket and ring. It is further contended that the axe used in the crime was recovered from the petitioner. All the injuries are grievous and caused by a sharp edged weapon.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and also have gone through the paper-book.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he along with the co-accused had inflicted grievous injuries upon the injured and the snatched gold chain and locket have already been recovered on the disclosure statement of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offences, I do not find any ground to grant him the concession of regular bail.

The present petition is dismissed.
