The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to provide adequate security to the petitioners who are stated to have been facing danger to their lives at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner even on second call.

The learned counsel for the respondent-U.T. has filed reply dated 31.10.2022 in the Court today, which is taken on record. A perusal of the reply would reveal that the statement of respondent No.4-Kalsum (mother of petitioner No.1-Gajala) has been recorded in which she has categorically stated that since the petitioner No.1 has left the house she has no concern with her and she faces no threat at the hands of the said respondent No.4.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in this case. Disposed of.
