Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and his family, as his father Dilbag Singh has registered FIR No.150 dated 24.08.2014 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 452, 120-B IPC and Sections 25/27/54 of Arms Act, at Police Station Gate Hakima, Amritsar against accused persons, however, they are not arrested.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of status report by way of affidavit of the Investigating Officer/SI Amarjit Singh, IC PP Anngarh, PS Gate Hakiman, District Amritsar City, filed in the Court today, has submitted that inquiry has been conducted and challan under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has also been presented before the Illaqa Magistrate on 17.02.2018. It is further stated

in the affidavit that during the investigation, the police officials namely Inspector Upkar Singh, HC Balwinder Masih, HC Kulwant Singh and HC Satpal Singh were declared innocent and were kept in column No.2.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to raise all the pleas/defences during the course of trial.
